TASTE OF LAND PARK RECAP

The 16th A Taste of Land Park was another successful event for the Land Park Community Association (LPCA). A Taste of Land Park is our only fundraiser and helps provide funding for park enhancements and improvements, the LPCA grants program, community events throughout the year, and various needs both within the park and in the neighborhood.



Urban Bicycling 101 Class





The class, normally held in City Hall, has been well-received and Downtown classes have been filling up fast. So, the LPCA asked Ms. Donlon Wyant if she could bring the class directly to our residents. Attendees received helpful information that explained how to traverse the City's streets, follow the rules of the road, avoid crashes, maintain their bicycle, and how to enjoy the ride. Additionally, Ben from City Bicycle Works shared various gear that bicycle riders can wear or attach to their bicycle to stay safe while riding.
