Dave Edrosolan Intent install bike lanes on Freeport Blvd. 2013 General Plan-Complete Streets Segment Sutterville North(City College) to Vallejo Intersection Design Freeport (Taylor's Market) 3 Concepts-Design The Freeport Blvd. Bike Lane Project – Presentation by Sacramento City Staff regarding restriping Freeport Blvd to accommodate bike lanes. 3 Options include:

1. Converting Freeport Blvd. to one traffic lane in each direction, keeping street parking, adding bike lanes to both sides of the street.

2. Converting Freeport Blvd. to one traffic lane in each direction plus a center turning lane, removing all street parking west side, adding bike lanes to both sides of the street, adding vertical curb for biking. 3. "No Bike Land Design" Converting Freeport Blvd. to two wider traffic lanes in each direction, removing all street parking, no bike lanes. (This option is considered the "no project" alternative. It brings the car lane width up to today's standards (11 ft) versus current 8.5ft. City Department of Transportation-Special Projects link to Freeport EIR available for comment in Summer, with planned finalization in Fall. Representatives offering divergent neighborhood, business and organizational perspectives will make short presentations to foster discussion of this important community project. 4 Intersection Design Concepts
