- Sun Flower Market Place Update Interior demolition is complete. Storefronts are now part of the bigger space. Waiting for the BLDG permits for the exterior for loading docks in rear. Possibly a roll up door, with down ramp. May cause issues with late night delivery of goods. Night loading may invite employee's to congregate and "loiter". In by April/ early summer.

 in store for that area.

Communications - Scott Rose.

- Website Training Our constant contact account is now active. We have templates to use. The last piece that needs attention is the public List Serve. The new service may allow the option to "reply only" vs. "reply all". We need to activate our website more with more updates and community interaction. We may need a person to take control of website PR. Constant Contact may be a solution. We receiving about a 60% read rate from this. What to do with posting website notices, newsletters, minutes, agendas etc? Scott may need a vice chair to support him.
- Newsletter. We may be able to get it to pay for itself. It is delivered to 8500 people. We need to have more articles written by more than Mark. A quarterly would be nice. Feasible? Ideas: How they are doing at Sun Flower, the Bike Lanes, Home Tour may need a post card. Each post card may need to be dedicated to one topic. - Upcoming Picnic & Flicks September 17th Update
- Home Tour Report It's coming together. 7 homes and the Fire Station on Broadway. The press releases are out. Signs are taken care of. The donations are coming in pretty good around 8,000. If we sell 600 tickets we may make close to \$20,000 with \$2500 in expenses. An LPCA committee will determine how proceeds are distributed to schools. April is organizing docents for houses. We need 70 or 80 docents. Hoping board members can do one or two, 2 hours shifts. April "will local vendors and sponsors have the opportunity to advertise or have a table during the event. SMUD? Land Use - Jon

- NWLP. The development committee has made some additions and changes to the park. They have added more features that are "nice". In some form or another the NWLP has met our objections in some way or another. The Upper Land Park group is happy with the proposed traffic circle @ McClatchy and 5th. NWLP (Ranch Capital) has supplied the funds for this-25K.

- P11-052, 515 Broadway Request for special permit to allow existing medicinal marijuana dispensary, NorCal Alternative Healing, in heavy

- commercial (C4) zone. Extension to September 19th. GBP is looking to comment to have owner improve the premises. Maybe LPCA works together with GBP to chime in on improvements.
- Permit application 980 3rd Ave. enlarged garage and second story apt. Does LPCA step in if adjacent neighbors do not speak up to issues concerning architectural context. If we are going to have a position we must have architectural guidelines.
- Permit application 515 Broadway continuation of existing marijuana dispensary
- Sunflower Mkt, Brew pub @ 1730 Broadway
- AIA Discussion of Complete Streets we should include SAFE in our discussions.
- Change of meeting date to second Tuesday on alternating months. Works for everybody.
- Brew Pub owner is on the board of the Greater Broadway Partnership. We need to put this on the agenda for this next meeting.
